

### B. Roles and Responsibilities:

- Nokari Mahamandal agrees that it will provide the following services and facilities to your students.
  - On-Line Job Portal All the students of the College will be registered on the on-line job portal maintained by Nokari Mahamandal.
  - 6000+ Local Companies Nokari Mahamandal's on-line job portal will be visited by more than 6000 local companies will be searching for the identifying the suitable candidates.
  - On-Line Campus Interviews will be arranged by Nokeri Mahamandal. To face such interviews and the students will be given sufficient training for this purpose.
  - College Login Password The College will be given the login password for the on-line job portal, so that the College can see all the data relating to their students.
