Q.No.1: Multiple choice questions (eight questions) $(1 \times 8 = 8 \text{ marks})$

Q.No.2: Long answer type questions

(any two out of four) $(2 \times 10 = 20 \text{ marks})$

Q.No.3: Short Notes (any three out of five) $(4 \times 3 = 12 \text{ marks})$
