**Courses & Discipline:** 2024 Year of Passing Graduates from Arts, Commerce & Science Streams. B. Com, BA, BAF, BBI, BBA, BBM, BMS, BSc (Maths, Physics, Chemistry, Botany, Zoology) from a recognized University / College.

Course Types: Only full-time courses will be considered (part-time / correspondence courses
will not be considered). Candidates who have completed their Secondary and / or Senior
Secondary course from NIOS (National Institute of Open Schooling) are also eligible to
apply if the other courses are full-time

- **Highest Qualification**: Candidates should have completed the course in the stipulated course duration (i.e., No extended education 3 years course should have been completed in the stipulated 3 years' time only)
- **Backlogs**: Only one backlog is permitted for the candidates from the 2024 year of passing, however all pending backlogs should be completed within the stipulated course duration.
